► Dandi Kutir - The Gandhi Museum

Located within the Mahatma Mandir, Dandi Kutir is the biggest permanent museum in the world based on the life of one person – Mahatma Gandhi. Shaped showcases every aspect of his life from birth to death portrayed through various fascinating media.

► AKSHARDHAM TEMPLE

Spectacular and awe-inspiring, Akshardham is one of the largest temple in India. Built of 6000 tonnes of pink stone with lavish carvings, it is surrounded by manicured gardens and fountains.

► INDRODA NATURE PARK

Indroda Nature Park is a combination of Deer Park and Dinosaur & Fossil Park. This is India's Jurassic region. The Park is the world's second largest hatchery of dinosaur eggs. Several fossilized dinosaur eggs and skeletal parts dating 65 million years back are well preserved in the Dinosaur Park.

► DANDI KUTIR THE GANDHI MUSEUM

Dandi Kutir is located inside a 41 meter high conical dome symbolizes a salt heap. This salt mound is a representations of Gandhiji's famous Dandi March of 1930 against the salt tax imposed by the British regime.

The high technology approach places every visitor to the museum in the shoes of the mahatma to learn and experience the dilemmas, struggles and sacrifices he faced in pursuing his pioneering ideas.

Dandi Kutir - The Gandhi Museum is based on his principles of Satyagraha (truthful force), Sarvodaya (Uprising All), Swaraj (Self-governance).

External museum shell is a giant replica of Salt Mound. The journey of Mohandas to Mahatma is spread in the large Salt Mound structure. Structured in 90 diameters, with 10,700 Square meters of permanent museum area and 1,900 Square meters of Temporary Exhibit. It raises new dialogues around a towering global figure. It also encourages multiple activities to happen simultaneously.
